## SEPTEMBER MEETING

Carroll's college degree is in Housing and Interior Design. She started quilting in 1983. At that time she converted her guest bedroom into a sewing room and decided to concentrate on quilting. She has made around 130 quilts and 90 quilted wearables.

Many of her quilted garment projects have a theme. Carroll was the featured artist at the Heart of the Valley Quilt Show in Modesto in January 1993 and featured wearable artist in January 2001. She is a Fairfield Fashion Designer with garments which toured the country in 1998 and 2000; both ensembles were among those featured in Quilter's Newsletter Magazine and in Sew News. She also has a Bernina Fashion Show ensemble premiering this fall. Her works have been featured in several books, such as "Scrap Quilts" by Roberta Horton and "Cotton Candy Quilts" by Mary Mashuta. Last year her work was displayed in a three-person show at the McHenry Museum in Modesto with work by Yvonne Porcella and Cathie Hoover. My work is known for its precise piecing, sense of humor and lively color sense. I will show some of my more contemporary quilts and clothing.
